



NATIONAL HIGHWAYS DEVELOPMENT PROJECT (NHDP)

SEVEN PHASES

- Phase-I: Mainly the Golden Quadrilateral (GQ) connecting major cities of the country namely Delhi, Mumbai, Chennai and Kolkata
- Phase-II: North–South and East–West Corridors
- Phase-III: Connection of State Capitals and important places to GQ and Corridors
- Phase-IV: Improvement of National Highways having single/ intermediate lane width to 2-lane with paved shoulders
- Phase-V: Six laning
- Phase-VI: Expressways
- Phase-VII: Bypasses, Ring Roads, Flyovers
